On January 21, 2019, William Adams, finished his race and went home where he belonged. Dad started his race in Bordentown, NJ and was the son of Allan & Rebecca Amy Adams. By the time he was in his teens both of his parents had passed away and Dad moved to Pedricktown to live with his sister and brother-in-law and worked on his family farm, the Kille's. In 1943 Dad decided to quit school and join the Navy. He served until 1946 and after being discharged worked several different jobs. Although no one in the family was a funeral director, Dad decided to become one. He attended Eckels Mortuary School in Philadelphia and graduated in 1954 and became a licensed funeral director in that same year. Along with his wife Natalie (Dolly) Nicholas Adams, they opened the Adams Funeral Home in Penns Grove. Dad was elected coroner in 1959 and would continue to serve in this position for many years. Never taking any real time off, Mom and Dad would continue to work until they retired, which they never really did. Like many of the greatest generation, they worked hard without question to make a better life for their children. Along the

way they did their part to build a country and a generation that will never be equaled.

When Dad first moved to Pedricktown, he attended the First Baptist Church there. After meeting Mom, he became catholic and the two were married in 1949 at St. James R.C. Church and whom he is survived by. They had three sons, Stuart, Scott and Marc and are survived by their respective families. All of Dad's siblings have predeceased him.

Over the years Dad has belonged to several organizations, the VFW, American Legion, Penns Grove Rotary, the Penns Grove-Excelsior Lodge #54 F. & A.M., The Washington Club, The Knight's of Columbus and St. James Father's Club to name a few. To relax, Dad loved to bake! During the holidays he would spend hours in the kitchen and just bake. I may be exaggerating but as a kid it seemed that the spare room we had was completely filled with tupperware and cookies of all sorts. Fortunately for us, he was a great cook as well. Dad also loved spending time in his yard, golfing and doing the repairs around the house and the funeral home.

All are invited to join us for a Mass of Resurrection on Saturday, January 26, 2019 at the Parish of St. Gabriel the Archangel, 369 Georgetown Road, Carneys Point, NJ 08069 at 11 AM. Afterwards, interment will take place at Lawnside Cemetery. Although there will be no viewing prior to mass, we would love to spend time with everyone at DiPoalo's after the interment. Everyone is welcome to join us at the cemetery or to go straight to the restaurant after the mass. 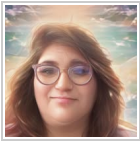
